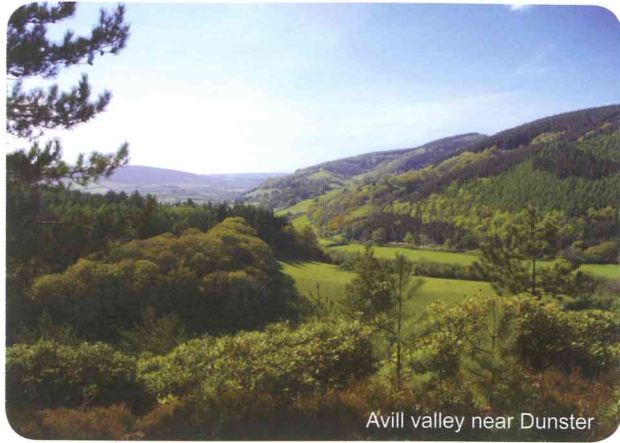

Exmoor National Park

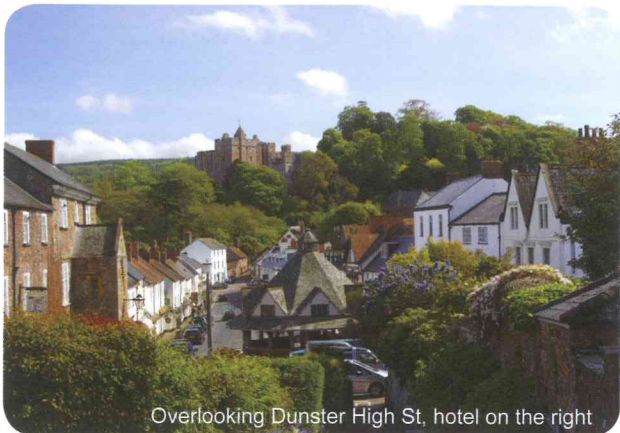
Enjoy deep wooded combes, open moorland, the highest sea cliffs in England and unspoilt villages, all a walk away from the hotel.

Go back in time to when travel was at a leisurely pace with a ride on this longest heritage railway.



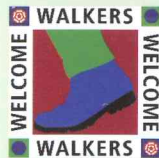
