The Scramble Experience at the Battle of Britain Memorial, Capel-le-Ferne,

Kent



The Battle of Britain Memorial, high on Kent's famous white cliffs, offers an exciting glimpse into the lives of the men who kept this country free from invasion in the summer and early autumn of 1940.

While the clifftop Memorial offers a chance for quiet reflection, The Scramble Experience in The Wing, the Trust's modern visitor centre, offers an interactive and immersive experience for all ages.

As well as numerous hands-on challenges and games, the high-tech, multi-media experience has hours of contemporary film and audio footage of the Few, together with a wealth of information, all accessible via modern touch screen technology.

Youngsters can dress up as a fighter pilot in the Experience's own dispersal hut, while families can compete to see who can shoot down the most enemy aircraft from the full-size replica Hurricane cockpit in a realistic video simulation.

At the heart of the experience is a unique, five-minute film specially commissioned for the Trust and revealing a little of the harrowing experience the Few lived through during the Battle of Britain.

Group bookings

Groups are welcome at the Memorial and The Scramble Experience. There is a dedicated coach park, reduced group rates and concessions for drivers and group organisers.

Coach parking

Coach parking for group bookings for the Scramble Experience is free, **but only if pre-booked**

Pricing

Pre-booked groups of 10 or more people pay £5 per person to visit The Scramble Experience (normal admission £6) Under-fives are free.

Drivers/tour guides

Accompanying tour leaders and coach drivers (maximum of three per coach) receive free admission to The Scramble Experience.

Site tours

Make your visit even more special by including a site tour (weather permitting). There is an additional charge of £30 for the tour, which needs to be pre-booked. Tours run for approximately 30 minutes and incorporate the history behind the Memorial as well as some key facts on the battle itself.

Numbers

We recommend splitting groups of 30 or more into two groups when visiting The Scramble Experience to make your visit more comfortable. There are plenty of other attractions that can be enjoyed by those who are waiting to enjoy the Experience. Alternatively, individual members of a group can enter the Experience whenever they wish.

Facilities

Our Cockpit Café offers fresh sandwiches, sausage rolls, meat slices, cakes and snacks as well as hot and cold drinks (including alcoholic beverages). We have modern toilet facilities.

Shop

Our well-stocked shop in The Wing offers a wide range of items including books, clothing, pocket-money priced souvenirs, model kits and jigsaws, as well as a unique range of signed memorabilia, from stamps sets and books to exquisite scale models of aircraft.

Accessibility

The whole of the site, including the external grounds and The Wing visitor centre, is fully accessible and there is a lift to the first floor Cockpit café.

Lunchtime bookings

Groups that will be visiting The Scramble Experience during the lunch period and expect to visit the Cockpit Café are asked to make this known when booking so that we can ensure sufficient sandwiches are available.
